STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary)

Attended Funeral

(Funeral Director’s charges only) **from £2900**

This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation.

Breakdown of Fees

Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£1,345
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.	£245-£295
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased person will be kept at the funeral director's branch of your choice.	£260
Providing a suitable coffin - this will be made from polished oak veneer	From £480
Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£10
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£450

Unattended Funeral

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (Funeral director's charges only)	from £3,911
Cremation (Funeral Director’s charges plus the cremation fee)	£1,810

Fees you must pay

For an attended or unattended burial funeral, the burial fee.*	£807
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee for local residents is:	£807
For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	
For an attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee.*	£935-£1215
In this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is:	£935

Additional Funeral Director Products and Services

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange on your behalf for a third party to supply them. Examples include:

Additional mileage
Additional transfers of the deceased (eg home, place of worship)
Collection and delivery of ashes
Embalming
Funeral officiant (celebrant, minister of religion etc)
Services supplied outside of normal hours
The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some of the arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier.

*This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.
